90 years History of St Oliver's A History of Harris Park

The area of Harris Park and Rosehill is steeped in history. The ground that we walk on was home, hunting ground and meeting place for thousands of years for the members of the Burramattagal clan of the Darug people. The Harris Park and Rosehill area was also among the very first land grants granted to convicts for farming to feed the new settlers in NSW. In 1788 the poor soil around Sydney Cove prompted Governor Phillip to establish a settlement on more fertile land at the head of what is now the Parramatta River. Some of the original buildings from the 1790's still stand, and are heritage listed. Most are open to the public.



For your **NORMAL CHOICE BOOKS**, you will need to enter the title and author of your choice book in the "add choice books" section of the website as usual.

For your **BONUS CHOICE BOOKS**, you will need to add the 2020 Bonus choice book records (pictured below) to your reading record.

To enter your bonus choice books on the main PRC site, please go to Student Reading Record, and type "2020 bonus" in the "Enter books" option. The bonus books will appear for you to add to your reading record.
